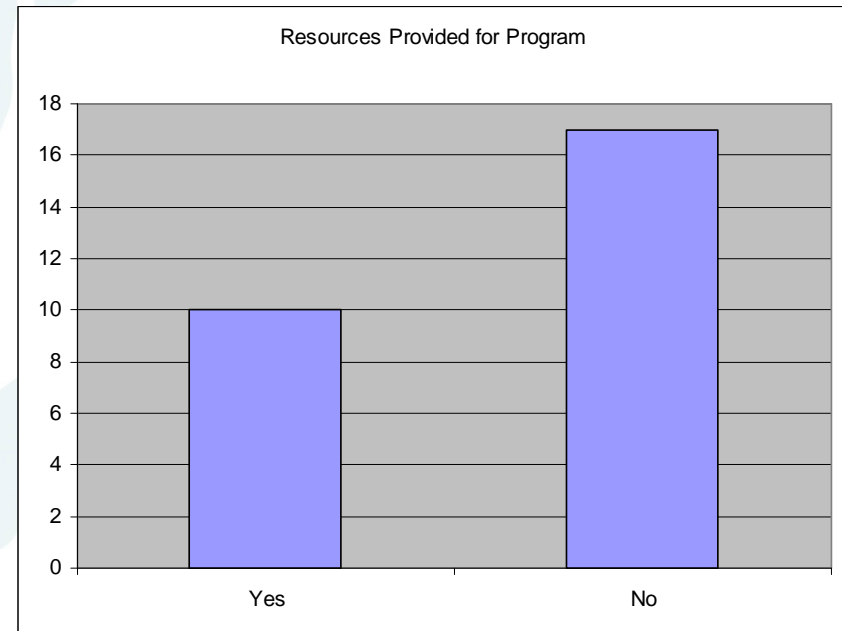
How Far Are We?

- Lead identified – 100%
- ABHR Product selected – 100%

- Education commenced – 100%*
- Auditing commenced – 50%
- Reporting commenced – 45%



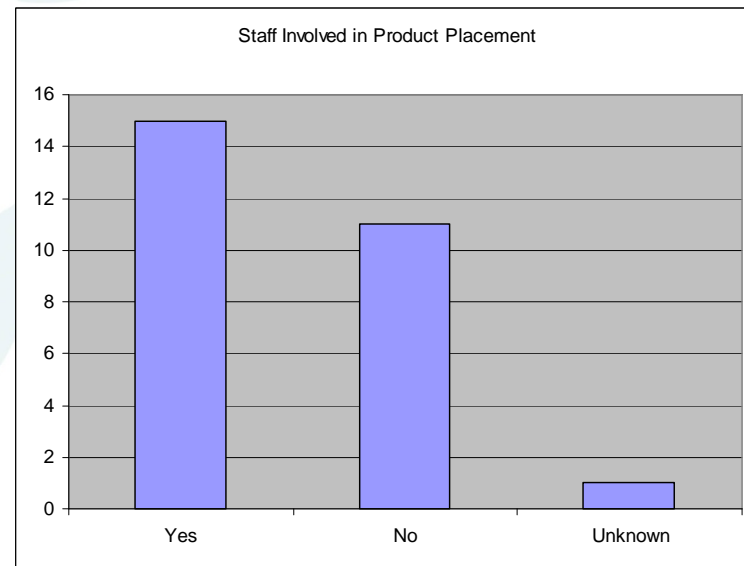
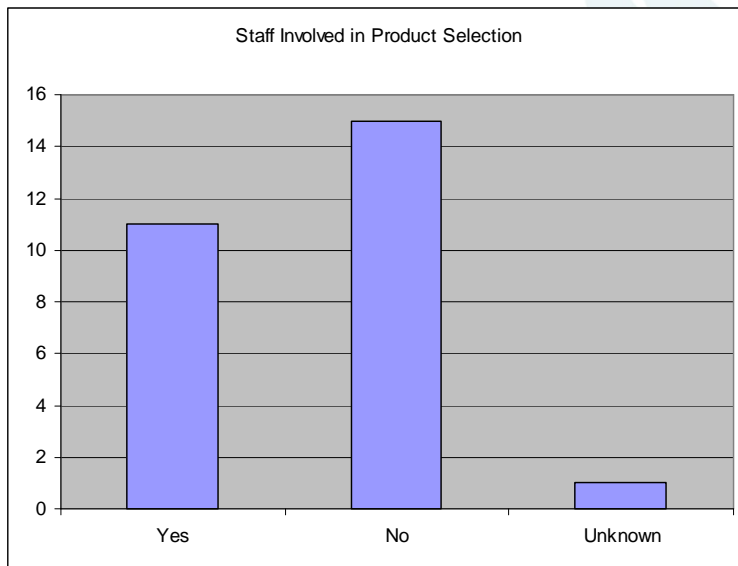
Pre-Visit Phone Survey

- 100% surveyed – less than half noted additional resources
- Readiness Status :

 - Low Priority: 9

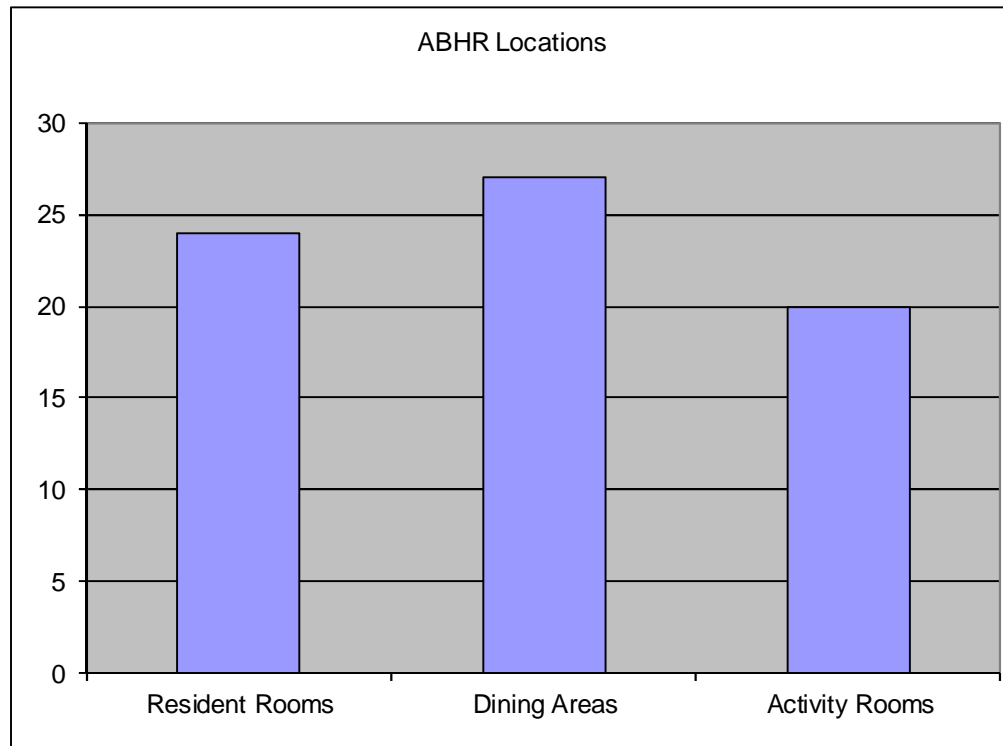


ABHR Product

ABHR Locations

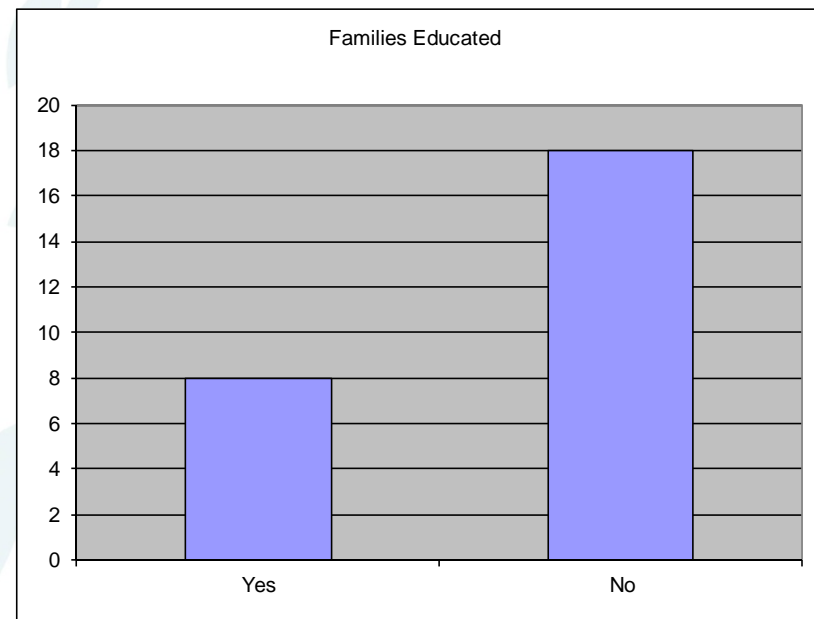
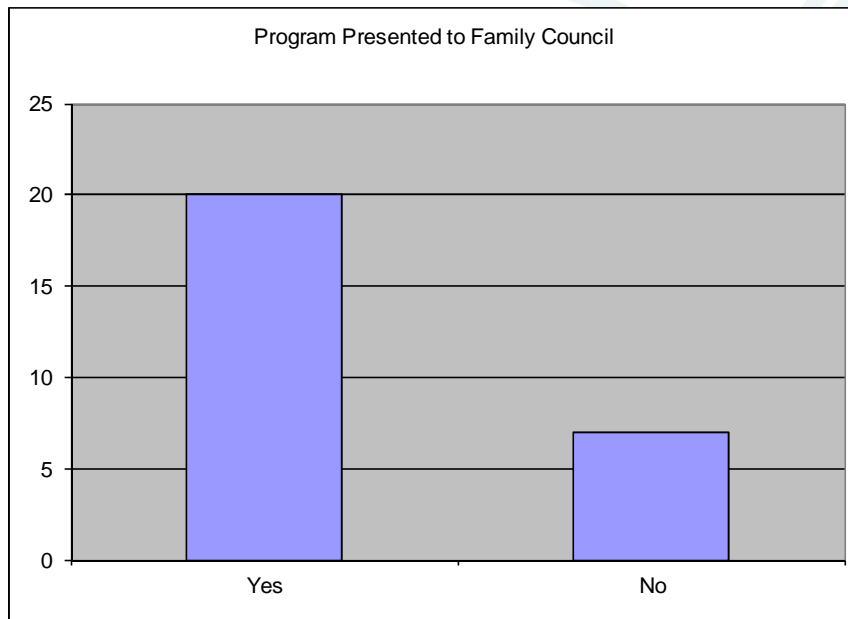


- But only 15% (MHICN) 47% (CWICN) are in resident bed space

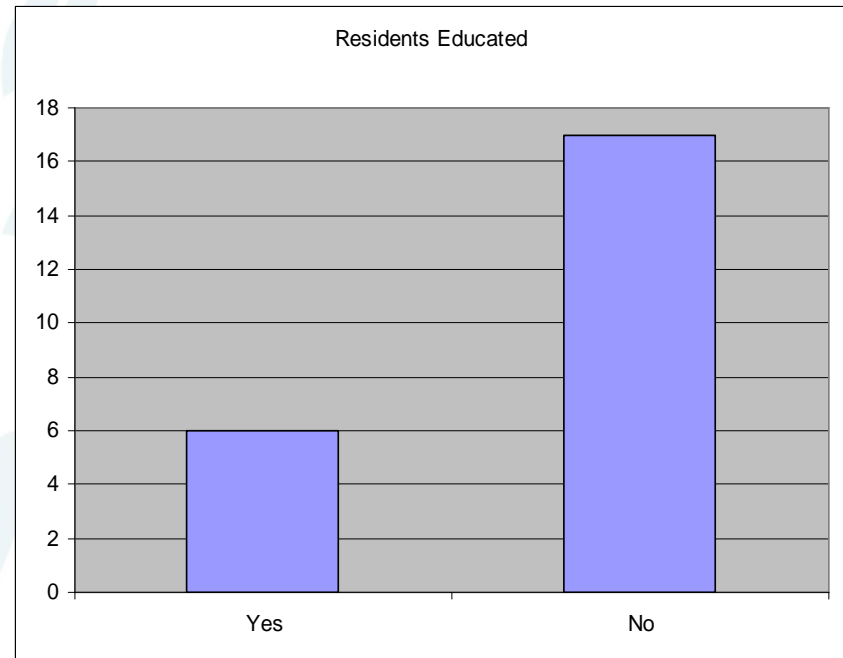
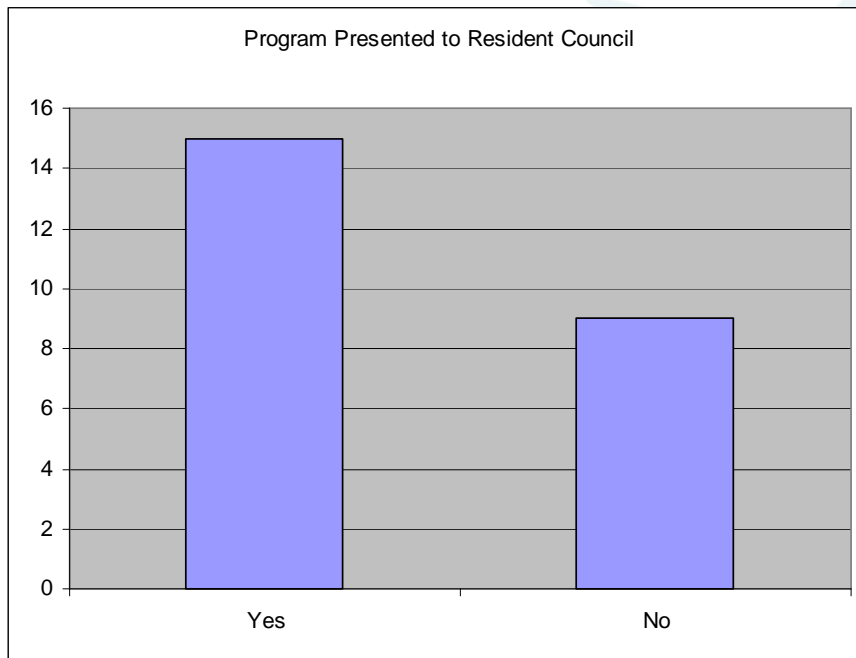
Education: Staff

- Leads:
 - All facilities had attended MHICN/CWICN initial and auditing training
 - 2 of the current leads had not participated in auditing training
 - 70% (MHICN) 90% (CWICN) describe the 4 moments
 - Staff training:
 - 81% direct care workers
 - 70% on all shifts
 - 59% (MHICN) 74% (CWICN) of non-direct care workers
 - Hand Care Issues:
 - 70% have hand lotion
 - 63% have designated person and 26% have a non-intact skin policy
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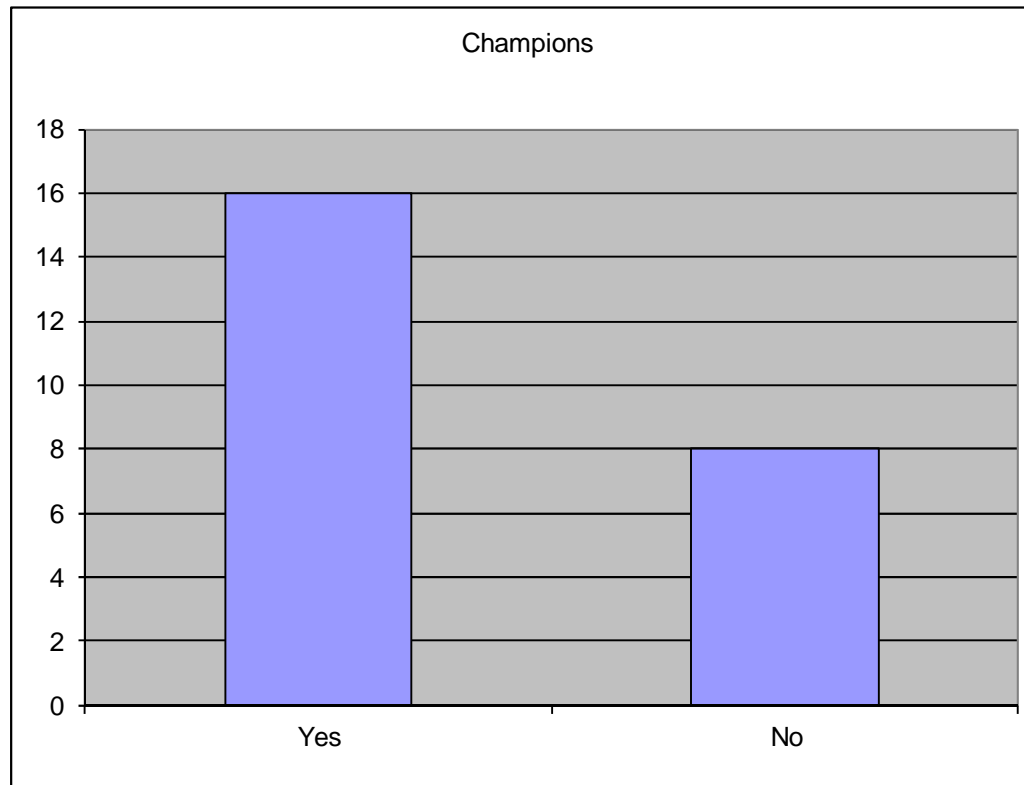

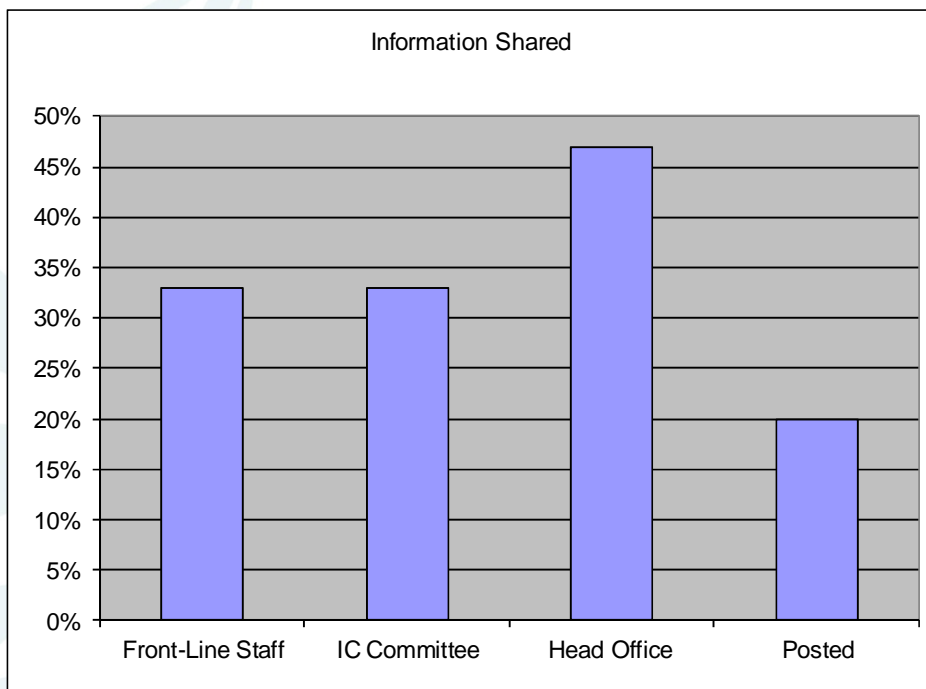
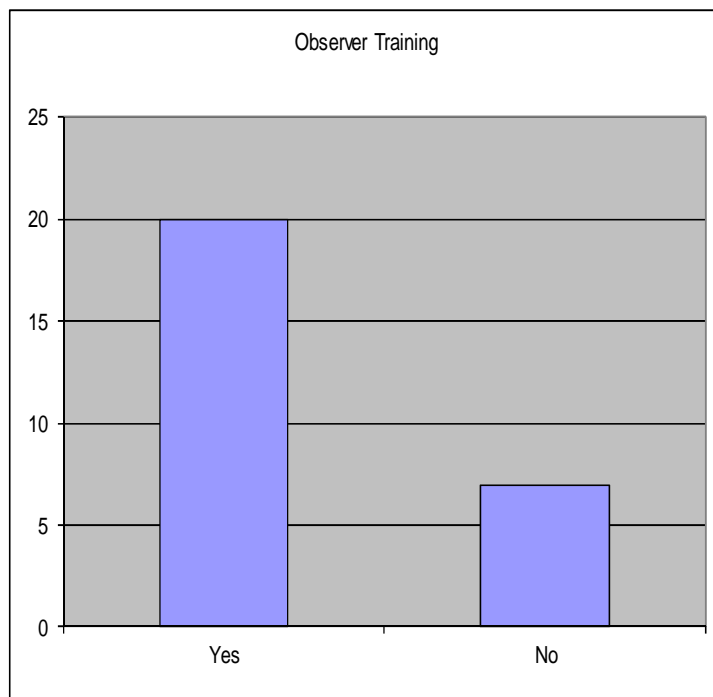

Tips for Success

• Product

- At wheelchair height
- Individual for residents with infection
- Try empty ones first for cognitively impaired
- Develop a good relationship with administration and maintenance to move dispensers when necessary
- Automatic at entrances
- Flags to indicate when empty

Tips for Success

Education

- Stop video and discuss gloves, etc.
 - Bring in coffee and donuts (nights)
 - Role model (Doctors too!)
 - Contest among units in home
 - Monthly quizzes for staff
 - HH tips in newsletters and internal program calendars
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More Tips for Success

- Promotion
 - Posters (elephant) and music (singing nurse)
 - Use the tools at every orientation and other mandatory education
 - Make it fun!
- Audits
 - Have each unit do their own
